

Scholarship for Organ Study Information and Instructions

The Central Arizona Chapter of the American Guild of Organists (CAZAGO) offers several scholarships for the purpose of helping new and continuing students with organ study. Piano students of junior high and high school age who live in Central Arizona may apply for an organ scholarship. Applicants must have attained at least an intermediate level of piano proficiency (i.e., Clementi Sonatas and Bach Two-Part Inventions).

Scholarships are awarded for 6 hour lessons or 12 half-hour lessons per semester. It is required that organ students study with a teacher who is an American Guild of Organists member. To apply, the application form on the next page must be completed, along with a letter of recommendation from his or her piano instructor. The student will then need to audition before the Central Arizona Chapter of the American Guild of Organists Scholarship Committee. Scholarships may be renewed up to three times, providing funds are available, for a total of four semesters of scholarship lessons. Additional auditions are not required, only the completion of a new application form along with their organ teacher's written recommendation.

Scholarship students are strongly encouraged to attend *Phoenix Youth Rising: Annual Organ Marathon Concerts*, the guild fundraiser for scholarship funds, at one of the valley locations. When the student is able, they are encouraged to perform for the annual Organ Marathon not only for the performance experience, but also to demonstrate to the contributing public the work of educating young artists, a mission that is vitally important to the Central Arizona Chapter of the American Guild of Organists.

A list of potential organ instructors will be provided upon request.

Auditions will be arranged at a time and location convenient for both the student and the scholarship committee. Application materials must be sent to:
