International Organ Concert Artist, Carlo Curley, will play the dedication concert of the Allen organ installed at the new Tri-City Ministries Campus. He will be joined by 90 other musicians from the church's orchestra, brass choir, and vocal choir for a special song offering. Born into a musical family in 1952, Carlo attended the North Carolina School of the Arts and coached privately with renowned pedagogues Arthur Poister and Robert Elmore. Ultimately, he studied with two of the world's greatest organists: America's legendary Virgil Fox and Great Britain's Sir George Thalben-Ball. If you have attended a Virgil Fox performance, you will recognize his influence on Carlo, both in the way he plays and in his enthusiasm as he talks about "The King of Instruments."

The 50 stop Allen Organ features two new technologies. Multi-Point Audio assigns different organ sounds to multiple audio channels and speakers to produce ensembles with dimension that rival the sound of actual wind-blown pipes. Stolist Library allows the organist to switch every stop on the organ to sounds recorded from famous German, English, French, or East Coast American pipe organs. This is the first organ in the Southwest with these new features. Tri-City Ministries new campus is about a mile south of the Chandler Fashion Mall on the SE corner of Price Road and Germann Road.
